Change to Sailing Instruction No.1

To acknowledge the 3 Buoy top mark system in the Sailing Instructions

Insert Clause 16 – 3 Buoys Race

- 3 Buoy Races shall be a scratch start
- Windward Mark as described in Courses shall be replaced by 3 Marks
 - Red Mark laid in proximity to windward mark as described in course description
 - White Mark laid downwind of the red mark
 - Blue Mark laid downwind of the white mark
- Distances between marks will vary depending on conditions
- No later than 12:30pm on the day of racing each boats mark rounding sequence shall be published.
- Minor movements of marks may occur during racing with no signals, however the sequence of red, white and blue will not change

Change to Sailing Instructions No. 2

To fix finish line description to be how the 18 Footers traditionally finish the race.

Delete Clause 4.1 and Insert

4.1.(a) The starting line will be between the mast of the Committee Vessel displaying a white rectangular flag with the Australian 18 Footers logo, at the starboard end of the line and the mast displaying a white rectangular Australian 18 Footers logo at the port end of the line.

4.1 (b) - Finish Lines

(I) Upwind Finish

The finish line will be between the mast of the Committee Vessel displaying a white rectangular flag with the Australian 18 Footers logo, at the starboard end of the line and the mast displaying a white rectangular Australian 18 Footers logo at the port end of the line.

(I) Downwind Finish

The finish line will be between the mast of the Committee Vessel displaying a white rectangular flag with the Australian 18 Footers logo, at the port end of the line and the mast displaying a white rectangular Australian 18 Footers logo at the starboard end of the line.



Change to Sailing Instructions No. 3

To describe how many races make up the Club Championship.

14.1.2 Such points will be scored on club conducted events as follows:

- Club Championship - There shall be thirteen(13) races, as listed on Calendar published on the 18 footers website, to count towards the Club Championship. There will be no discard
